Racing Sim Series

Enter your Corporate Teams into our exciting Racing Series where you will compete with your company's team of 4 Drivers. Each company team will be challenged in Grand Touring, Rally Car, and Formula One formats, racing to win the Series Trophy at the end of the season for your company.



What is Sim Racing?



Imagine sitting behind the wheel of a high performance sport car clutching the steering wheel, foot on the accelerator, hand on your gear stick, ready to blast off in your race to take the checkered flag!

Our Racing Simulators at The Matrix offers you the experience of competing against other drivers in a wide range of racing formats -- Grand Touring, Rally Car and Formula 1 racing. The very nature of auto racing is one of healthy competition against other racers as well as with yourself - trying to achieve your best lap time and become the best driver you can be. When competing for your team in our corporate league, you are doing your best to help your teammates and representative company sit on the victory podium.

The Matrix Corporate Sim Racing League is a fun, social, business-vs-business league designed to help companies connect, network, and build community outside of the office. This seasonal league combines friendly competition with a relaxed, beginner-friendly atmosphere — making it easy for teams to play, socialize, and build real connections on and off the track.

How does the Corporate Sim Racing League work?



- 1) A Racing Team consists of 4 drivers, with at least one of the drivers female (all 4 drivers can be female!)
- 2) Each week, your team will race against 3 other teams on a specific race track with a specific car.
- 3) Every week, the track and car changes in our 6 | week season. Each Season, there is a different type of racing: Grand Touring, Rally and Formula 1.
- 4) Each team is allowed 4 alternate drivers, but only 4 drivers per night per team will race.
- 5) Each team ranks their 4 drivers A, B, C, and D, based on their perceived skill level with A being the fastest, D being the slowest.
- 6) Each driver will have 2 races each night, which lasts approximately 15-20 min per race. Points are awarded to each driver based on how they place in each of their 2 races.
- 7) Each night there will be a winning team, fastest driver per night and the team points accumulate each week.

What makes our Corporate League different from others?

Often women are made to feel less-than when they compete in other corporate leagues. Unlike most corporate leagues that are centered around athletics, Sim Racing offers no unfair advantages to males that many sports naturally do. A good Sim Racer relies on a few factors - racing tactics, driving skill, and mental focus --- each of these traits are not gender related and are in equal proportion in both men and women.

Being physically bigger or stronger offers no advantage to a Sim Race Driver. Both men and women compete as equals in this series, the ultimate Female Friendly Corporate League!



How does the Season Work?



The Matrix Sim Racing Corporate League season is divided into 3 terms, --- Fall (Sept - Nov), Winter (Jan - Mar) and Spring (April - May). Each term will be a 6 week series of racing, and each term will feature different type of racing (Grand Touring = Fall, Rally Car = Winter, Formula 1 = Spring).

The Fall session will also include a night of qualifying racing, where teams come down and do 2 time trials per driver in order to establish what the fastest to slowest driver on each team - A, B, C and D ranking. These A-D rankings are not static and will be adjusted as the races go on. If you start as a C level driver, you could go up or down based on your best track times / placement as the season progresses. The faster you drive, the higher the level of your competition is. The faster you and your teammates drive, the better your team does.

The Time Trial evening at the start of the Fall session is also a chance to ask questions that you may have, both as a driver as well as team questions that you might have. It will be a social, but competitive first evening of racing before the actual racing series begins, and promises to be a lot of fun!

Counting Points and Placement



At the end of each night, the placements of each team are announced, along with the fastest driver for the evening. The winner of the fastest driver of the night will receive a \$25 Matrix Gift Card/ Credit to use towards any future Matrix booking.

Each week, teams accrue points that go add up each race week until the end of the seasonal term. At the end of the 6th week of racing, the team winner of that term is heralded the winner for that particular class of racing, alongwith the top driver of the term.

End of the Season Championship

At the end of the 3 terms, an overall winning Team and fastest driver will be presented an award for winning the 2026-27 Championship. The company of the winning team will receive Matrix Voucher for a Free 2 hour Full Upstairs Booking to be used for a team-building event and engraved medals for each of the team's drivers.



The fastest driver will win a \$100 Matrix Gift Certificate to be used at their convenience, and an engraved medal.

The company name and team members of the winning team will be engraved on the Corporate League Grand Prix Trophy, and the fastest driver will also be engraved on our Speed Demon Trophy.

Dates & Team Registration

Each team will have 4 drivers racing seven evenings for the Fall session, and six races for the Winter and Spring sessions. The cost for per team of drivers to join the 2026-27 Sim Racing Corporate League is \$600 per term. Each season consists of 3 terms and is limited this season to just 8 Corporate Teams.

Fees are payable in advance of each term to secure your team's registration in the league. It is not possible to join the Corporate League for less than 3 terms.

Racing will begin at 6:30pm each scheduled racing night. If racers are late and miss their first race, then they will only have one heat to use as the best time for the evening. Substitute drivers can be used without notice to replace drivers. To be an eligible driver for a team, you must be an employee of the company or spouse of an employee.
